

## PATROL OFFICER'S CHECKLIST

Officers must report for duty with all assigned equipment, plus any additional items they may need. Most officers keep a duty gear bag which contains all duty belt items. They also stock and carry a patrol bag containing any other items needed. This checklist will save time and ensure important items are not left behind.
